# BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Black History Month
serves as a reminder of
the struggles and
triumphs of African
Americans, from the fight
against slavery and
segregation to
contributions in science,
literature, art,
politics, and beyond. It

also fosters conversations about

Harriet Tubman was born a slave. When she was older she escaped from slavery then helped others do the same as a conductor on the Underground Railroad. She led passengers to safehouses.

These were homes and businesses that took in escaped slaves on their road to freedom. She made about nineteen trips to the South and helped over three hundred slaves escape.

Black History Month was created in 1962 by Dr. Carter G. Woodson, a Harvard-educated historian often referred to as the "The Father of Black History." Woodson, along with what is now known as the Association for the Study of African American Life and History, sought to honour the achievements of African Americans and recognize their central role in history. In the 1960's, during the Civil Rights Movement, awareness of African American history and contributions grew, leading to the expansion

of the full month. In
