### IPAC UPDATES

Country Village Homes has adopted the Public Health Ontario's Urinary Tract Infection (UTI) program in the home. This is to prevent and reduce overuse of antibiotics amongst our residents. This will also ensure that best practices are followed in the management of UTIs. Please speak to our registered staff, MD or NP or any member of management team about our UTI program.

The Spring COVID vaccine clinic is on the way for eligible residents. The Ministry of Health recommends a spring COVID vaccine booster for residents of long term care homes. Please speak any member of our management team, MD or NP if you have any questions or concerns about the COVID vaccine booster or any other vaccines.

The Windsor Essex County Health Unit (WECHU) has reported an increase in amount of cases of measles in the area, in line with the rest of Ontario. Please reach out to your healthcare provider if you're unsure of your vaccination status for measles, as vaccines remain an important step in the prevention and spread of measles. We are also recommending that families, visitors and staff stay away from the home when they are not feeling well. This would enable us to prevent transmission of infection of any kind to residents and prevent outbreaks in the home.
